Services Agencies and Community Resources Providing Resident Advocacy Services Guide

Dear Nursing Home Administrator:

This letter is to inform you that the Nursing Home Legal Services Agencies and Community Resources Providing Resident Advocacy Services Guide ("Guide") has been updated with the most current information, including the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program and Office for the Aging Local Offices directories located at the end of the Guide. Please update your copy with this information.

New York State regulation at Title 18 of New York Codes, Rules and Regulations, sections 487.5(f)(5), 488.5(e)(7), and 490.5(f)(7) require that "in addition to the prescribed termination notice, the operator shall furnish to the resident a list of agencies, including the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program, providing free legal services and agencies engaged in resident advocacy services within the geographic vicinity of the facility. Such lists must be provided or approved by the Department and shall include names, addresses and telephone numbers." Operators are responsible to review the information in the Guide for accuracy prior to providing it to the resident. If additional and/or other updates are identified, please notify the Division of Nursing Homes and ICF/IID Surveillance ("Division") via the regional office program team.
